Dubai Creek

Dubai Creek has been described as a natural saltwater creek, tidal inlet, and watercourse or waterway in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. It extends about 9 miles inwards and forms a natural port that has traditionally been used for trade and transport.

Historical Bastakiya

Al Fahidi Historical District, commonly referred to as Al Bastakiya, holds the memories of an era that pre-dates the federation of the Emirates.

Dubai is known for glitz and glamour, but before the tourism boom, before the discovery of oil and before the union of the Emirati tribes in 1971, it was a vastly different place. The UAE was an area of sheikhdoms – where Bedouins lived as herders, date farmers and fishermen.

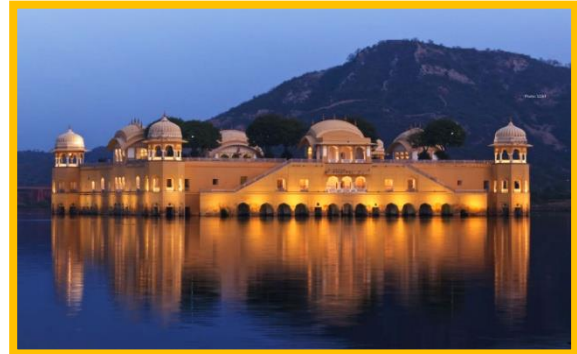

After breakfast, and enjoy sightseeing tour of Jaipur - the picturesque capital of Rajasthan. Visit Amer Fort **Amber Fort (by Elephant ride) Subject to availability** - Amber is located at a distance of 11 kilometres from Jaipur and was the old fort of the Kachhwaha clan of Amber, which used to be the capital, till it was moved to Jaipur. The fort is built with white marble and red sandstone and looks even more attractive because of the Maota Lake in the foreground. The fort in itself is a beautiful sight to behold but as one looks on the fort with its clear reflection on the lake in the front one cannot help but wonder if it is a dream or a beautiful illusion



City Palace, the former royal residence built in a blend of the Rajasthani and Mughal styles. **Jantar Mantar** is the largest of the five observatories built by Sawai Jai Singh.

The **Hawa Mahal** or the Palace of Winds was constructed for the royal ladies to watch the royal processions without being seen. Late evening return to hotel. Overnight at hotel.

TAJ MAHAL: The Taj is a white marble mausoleum located in Agra, Uttar Pradesh, India. It was built by Mughal emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his third wife, Mumtaz Mahal. The Taj Mahal is widely recognized as "the jewel of Muslim art in India and one of the universally admired masterpieces of the world's heritage" Taj Mahal is regarded by many as the finest example of Mughal architecture, a style that combines elements from Islamic, Persian, Ottoman Turkish and Indian architectural styles. In 1983, the Taj Mahal became a UNESCO World Heritage Site. While the white domed marble mausoleum is the most familiar component of the



it is actually an integrated complex of structures. The construction began around 1632 and was completed around 1653, employing thousands of artisans and craftsmen. The construction of the Taj Mahal was entrusted to a board of architects under imperial supervision, including Abdul-Karim Ma'mur Khan, Makramat Khan, and Ustad Ahmad Lahauri. Lahauri is generally considered to be the principal designer.

AGRA FORT: This Great Monument Of Red Sandstone Dominating A Bend In The River Yamuna, 2km Northwest Of Taj Mahal Was Constructed By The Mughal During 1565-1571. It Was Emperor Akbar Who Laid The Foundation Of This Majestic Citadel In 1565. The Fort was ready By 1571 Period of Shahjahan's, Akbar's Grandson and You Will Have Time to Shopping in Agra, Agra Is Famous for Precious Marble.
